Church Marks 500th Anniversary of Reformation with Luther Musical *Our Saviour's to Host October 15 Performance of Martin Luther, Rebel Priest*

FAIRFIELD, Conn., September 27, 2017 – Can't get a ticket to the Broadway hit *Hamilton*? Why not attend a free performance of *Martin Luther, Rebel Priest* instead?

Our Saviour's Lutheran Church is hosting an encore performance of this historical musical on Sunday, October 15, at 4 pm, to mark the 500th anniversary of the Protestant Reformation this year. The cast includes professional actors and singers Richard Weidlich as Luther and David Victor as the Narrator, as well as amateur performers from the OSLC Players. Martin Luther's wife, Katharina von Bora, will be portrayed by Ericka Tennant, a Fairfield Ludlowe High School student who can trace her ancestry on her mother's side back to the real Katharina.

Martin Luther, Rebel Priest was written and composed in 1983 by famed American composer and lyricist [Carmino Ravosa](#) (1930-2015) to commemorate the 500th anniversary of Luther's birth. A lifelong music educator, Ravosa was an author and editor for Silver Burdett & Ginn's music textbook series "World of Music" and "The Music Connection." Ravosa also was the songwriter for the CBS children's shows *Captain Kangaroo* and *Romper Room*, the PBS program *Shining Time Station*, and the PBS publication *Sesame Street Magazine*.

Vividly, and with historic integrity and humor, *Martin Luther, Rebel Priest* brings to life the story of Martin Luther's reformation challenge to the Roman Catholic Church in 1517. The musical was staged at Our Saviour's in April, and this encore performance marks only the second time the musical has been publicly performed in the last 34 years. Originally it was performed in 1983 at Ravosa's home congregation, Emanuel Lutheran Church in Pleasantville, N.Y., to mark the 500th anniversary of Luther's birth, and by students of the Dalton School in New York City, where the composer taught at the time.

Free and open to the public, the October 15 performance will be followed by a reception featuring German-style refreshments. A free-will offering will be collected, with proceeds to benefit the Council of Churches of Greater Bridgeport.
